REFLECTION - Small and Simple

Each of us has our own way of coping with challenging situations. Often it is the small and simple acts that help to put things in their right perspective. A friend of mine takes time out and slowly brews a cup of tea. Whenever I feel anxious or distressed, a favourite piece of music and a good night's rest helps restore the balance. There is something soothing about the return to the ordinary and familiar.



The gospels give us insights into how Jesus restores the balance. Each Sunday we listen to some of the challenging situations he faced. Of stresses and pressures, he certainly has his fair share. When he confronts the prospect of his own violent death, he confides in his closest friends. They are not ready to face up to the hard truth and change the subject, the gist of their talk being who among them is the greatest - and this is after three years of living closely with Jesus. These two things alone are enough to cause stress, disappointment and even a sense of failure.

So what does Jesus do to place it all into perspective? He simplifies the discussion and does what he has done all his life. He lowers himself to the level of smallest and most defenceless person standing before him, offers a simple gesture of love and invites us all to do the same (*Kathryn Williams pddm*)

Pope Francis has some wise words again: A daily round, whether of the individual or the community that is marked by dissatisfaction or bitterness that keeps us complaining, permanently nostalgic for paths unexplored and dreams unrealized, becomes a lonely road.
