REFLECTION - Multiple Cries

As you listen to today's Gospel what images spring to your mind? What emotions move you when you think about this blind man as he sits in the gutter and realizes that Jesus is leaving town? Then, quite unexpectedly Jesus hears the desperate and persistent cry and stops in his tracks, calling Bartimaeus closer. I was reminded of the parable of the Good Samaritan, aware that many similar scenarios are very familiar to us. They play on our TV screens each evening and we encounter them each day.



Many scenes..... Someone silently watching through barbed wire, another

wrapping herself up in newspaper to stall the cold, countless others staring blankly into the future knowing that more hunger awaits them. Other scenes are less dramatic although not less painful. There is the quiet loneliness of the high rise dweller, the unhappiness of the estranged family members or the slow disintegration of the life of the addicted brother of sister. These cries (unlike the cry of Bartimaeus) are usually more of a whimper, whisper or moan, unsure of being heard. Perhaps today, as I reflect on this gospel, I might pray for those who courageously and persistently seek to become the voice of the poor. I could also seek out ways in which I might join my voice to theirs. (*Kathryn Williams pddm*)
