### **REFLECTION - On Baptisms**

Do you remember being baptized? Perhaps you were a baby. If so, your only remembrance of it would be the faded black and white snap of a barely seen, wordless infant snuggled up and enfolded in a crocheted and pre-loved gown. That day others stepped in for you and spoke on your behalf. They knew the



baptismal gift was precious and they wanted you to be enriched with it right from infancy.

Jesus, on the other hand, was aware of everything when he was baptized. When he quietly stepped into the Jordan waters, there was that breath-taking moment when he tasted the overwhelming love of God and how God delighted in everything about him.
