REFLECTION - Vision therapists

Twelve years ago I received my first pair of reading glasses. Whereas once I could read the White Pages without a blink, now I cannot even decipher the names or numbers - even if I squint! So these last few years have made me quite appreciative of the



skilled work of people like opticians, ophthalmologists and optometrists; they help us see things more clearly.

If we think about it, the ministry of Jesus is precisely that: helping people see more clearly. Jesus refers to himself as a physician, but we could also say that his greatest specialization is in the field of vision...he's a vision therapist!

Besides healing physical eyesight, however, Jesus attends to a much wider aspect of seeing; he desires that we see God as he does. In today's gospel, he paints an accurate picture and holds it up for all to see. The picture Jesus presents is that of a God who is Father - the finest and best of fathers. Our Lord has a heart of flesh that aches and breaks for his lost children. Sadly, *both* sons in the story had developed a blurred and distorted vision of their father.

Perhaps today as we think about or own vision of God, we might ask Jesus for the clarity of vision to see God through his own eyes (Kathryn Williams pddm)
