

REFLECTION

The "suffering servant" song from Isaiah echoes the same message as the Gospel story - that Jesus is the Chosen One, who is to bring light and salvation to all nations and all peoples. Paul's letter reminds us that as a holy people, as followers of Jesus, we share in that mission.
