

REFLECTION

God has high standards for the leaders of the faith. Malachi speaks of God's anger when the scribes and the Pharisees do not give a good example for the people to follow. And Jesus criticizes the huge tassels, the places of honour at banquets, and the special titles of those trying to exalt themselves. They talk the talk, but they don't walk the walk. Paul compares doing God's work to the gentle care a mother gives her babies when fondling them and nursing them. The only great ones are the ones who serve others. The only ones who will be exalted are those who humble themselves.

FIRST READING (Malachi 1:14-2:2,8-10)

The prophet Malachi explains that God is unhappy with the religious leaders who are not teaching faith by their example.

SECOND READING (1Thessalonians 2:7-9,13)

Paul reminds the young church of Thessalonica of his example to them of gentle care and of preaching God's Good News.

GOSPEL (Matthew 23:1-12)

Jesus tells his followers to listen to the things the scribes and the Pharisees say, but not to follow the example of these religious leaders.
