# **Update**

The Covid-19 figures this week again remind us of the risks we can still face regarding Covid-19.

With this in mind the approach being taken by the parish in relation to some kind of return to normality is a slow and cautious approach.

- In relation to Masses we currently have capacity for all those who wish to attend Mass and thankfully have not had to turn anyone away from Sunday or Weekday Masses in any of the Churches in the Parish. We are reviewing these numbers every week and will do a full review of Masses when the Government make the move to Phase 4 of the re-opening plan.
- Our first and only concern is the welfare and safety of our parishioners
- We are living in a very strange time and this calls for understanding and patience from everyone as we as a parish deal with the backlog of work created by the lock down and the reality that we are also preparing in excess of 150 Candidates for first Confession, 150 Candidates for First Holy Communion and 150 Candidates for Confirmation, more than 40 Baptisms and a number of rescheduled Weddings, as well as dealing with the day to day work of the Parish along side working with schools to try to reopen all 8 primary schools in the Parish on time.

As a community we have done very well in working together to keep each other safe and well. Like all of you, we too are tired and a little fed up with Covid-19 and all that it brings, but now is a time for us to remain alert, not to drop our guard and continue to work together to protect our community from this killer disease.

# The Sacrament of Confirmation this year in our Parish.

We will have six ceremonies in Ss. Peter & Paul's Church on Thursday Friday & Saturday September 17th, 18th and 19th. We look forward to the celebration with those to be Confirmed, their Parents and Teachers.
