

"I am asking two things of families whose children will shortly celebrate the Sacraments. Firstly, I ask that you help your children to prepare as much as possible as they get ready to receive the Holy Spirit for Confirmation. Make that the focus. Secondly, if you choose to have a family celebration afterwards, please keep it simple and pay full attention to the public health guidelines which will help to protect you and your families and friends." "In the final analysis, this is advice by Government rather than regulation."
