The 1st Sunday of Advent Year C marks the beginning of the new liturgical year.

This season prepares us for the coming of Jesus at Christmas and at the end of time.

- Hope in God's Promise: Jeremiah speaks of God's promise to bring justice and righteousness. This reminds us to trust in God's
  plans.
- Faithful Waiting: Jeremiah shows God's faithfulness in fulfilling promises. We learn to wait with faith and patience.
- Love and Increase: Paul prays for love to increase in the Thessalonians. This teaches us to grow in love and holiness.
- Holiness and Conduct: Paul urges the Thessalonians to live in holiness. We are reminded to live in ways that please God.
- Watchfulness: Jesus warns of signs and the need to be vigilant. We should stay alert and faithful, ready for His coming.
- **Prayer and Strength:** Jesus calls for prayer and strength to face challenges. We rely on prayer to stay strong in our faith.

The 1st Sunday of Advent Year C encourages us to prepare our hearts and lives for Jesus' coming. Through hope, love, and vigilance, we grow closer to Him.
